RECIPE OF THE MONTH

MUESLI CRISP SLICE

- 1\2 cup brown sugar
- 1 tablespoon golden syrup
- 100g Flora pro-activ Buttery (or 100g butter)
- 2 cups of Muesli (Swiss style if available)
- 2 wheat breakfast biscuits crushed

METHOD:-

Pre-heat oven to 180c. Line a 28 x 18cm baking tin with baking paper
Place brown sugar, golden syrup and butter in a saucepan over a low
Heat and stir until the sugar is dissolved. Allow to cool.

Place muesli and crushed biscuits in a mixing bowl. Add the cooled
melted mixture and mix well. Empty the mixture into the prepared
tin and press down evenly and firmly.

Bake for 15 minutes before turning the tin around. Bake for a further
5 minutes or until golden brown. Cool in tin before transferring to a
wire cooling rack.

Tip. Add sultanas for some extra taste.
