RECIPE CORNER

BANANA LOAF. Good way to use up over ripe Bananas

3 Ripe Bananas  
1 and 1/2 cups plain flour  
1 cup Sugar  
65grms softened butter  
1 teasp. Vanilla essence  
1/2 teasp. Baking powder  
1 teasp'. Baking soda  
1 egg.

METHOD  
Mash bananas, add all ingredients and mix well  
Place into greased loaf tin.  
Bake at 180 degrees  
50 - 60 minutes or until cooked.
