## Chocolate Rough Biscuits

A family. Favourite

225g butter.

2 Tbsp Cocoa

1cup sugar

1 Tsp baking Powder

1teasp vanilla

Little boiling water

2 cups flour

Sugar for sprinkling

1 ½ cups coconut

### Method -

Cream butter and sugar, add vanilla then dry ingredients. Mixture should be a little dry. Add a little boiling water just enough to enable mixture to be formed into small balls. Place walnut-sized balls on lightly greased trays. Flatten slightly with a fork and sprinkle each with a little sugar.

Bake in a moderate oven (180) until cooked, about 12 minutes. Cool on wire rack then store in a cookie tin.
